**Proposal:** Alteration and change of use of existing domestic workshop to form a dwelling

**Location:** High View Mereside Flamborough East Riding Of Yorkshire YO15 1LA

**Application type:** Full Planning Permission

**Proposal:** Erection of single storey extension to front (AMENDED PLANS)

**Location:** Glengarth, Water Lane, Flamborough, East Riding Of Yorkshire, YO15 1PN,

**Applicant:** Mr Arthur Woodhouse

**Application type:** Full Planning Permission

There were no objections to this application.

### 76/18 To agree to installation of a mirror on Bempton Lane opposite Flaen Rd to improve road safety.

Council were informed that the Highways authority did not recommend the use of mirrors on the public highway and if the Council agreed to the installation of a mirror it would be liable in the event of an accident. Cllr Grainger proposed that the installation was not approved due to the opposition of the Highways authority. Cllr Toft stated that she thought this would be helpful to drivers so should be allowed. Cllr

Sellick informed Council that this would place a liability on Council in the event of an accident. Cllr Morton reminded Council that a similar request had been turned down for Lighthouse Road and therefore the Council had set a precedent for this issue. Cllr Crossland proposed that as the Council were not the Highway Authority the applicant should be asked to apply to this authority for permission to install a mirror. Council discussed this and voted 9 in favour of this proposal and one against. **RESOLVED** Council to advise resident that it could not give permission to install a mirror on the streetlight on Bempton Lane and that the resident should seek permission from the Highways Authority of East Riding of Yorkshire Council.

Cllr Crossland then left the meeting but before doing so he stated that he was appalled by the work carried out by the contractors for Yorkshire Water. He said that the traffic management system in the village had been in place for far longer than was needed and there had been problems on North Landing Road. He proposed that Yorkshire Water be asked to attend a meeting of the Parish Council to explain why this had occurred.

After Cllr Crossland left it was noted that the Clerk had been in contact with Yorkshire Water and they were investigating these complaints. Council discussed this and proposed that Yorkshire Water still be invited to a future meeting.

**RESOLVED** Clerk to ask Yorkshire Water to attend a future meeting of the Parish Council.

**77/18 To consider a proposal to exclude the public and press from item 10 on the agenda on the grounds of confidentiality.** This was agreed.

**78/18 To consider quotes for repairs to public toilets**  
Council agreed to award the contract for repairs and painting of the public toilets to Alec Grainger who had submitted a quote.

The meeting ended at 8.02pm
