## Local Council Elections – 7<sup>th</sup> May 2015

This year for the first time Parish Elections will be combined with East Riding of Yorkshire Council Ward elections and the Parliamentary elections.

Flamborough Parish Council has thirteen seats up for election and this is your chance to become a parish councillor and have your say on local issues affecting Flamborough, contribute to making decisions that affect Flamborough and really make a difference to village services and community life.

If you have a keen interest in what happens to Flamborough and are prepared to make decisions, this could be the role for you.

## To be a Parish Councillor You Must:

- Be over 18 on the day of election and be a UK, EU or Commonwealth citizen and;
- Be a local government elector for the parish, **or**
- have lived within the Parish (or within 3 miles of it) for the past 12 months; or
- have occupied as an owner or tenant any land or premises within the Parish for the past 12 months; or
- have had your main place of work within the Parish for the last 12 months
- Don't forget to vote on 7<sup>th</sup> May for your new Parish Council

## You <u>Cannot</u> be a Councillor If:

- You work for the Parish Council; or
  - You are an undischarged bankrupt; or You have been sentenced to more than three months imprisonment (whether suspended or not) within five years of the date of the election

### Dog Fouling

Following a resident's request, a new litter and dog waste bin has been installed at the bottom of Water Lane at the beginning and end of a popular dog walking path. However despite numerous bins around the village, dog fouling continues to be a concern with owners not picking up after their pet or leaving bags on grass verges and footpaths. There is no excuse for not picking up and the Council will continue to monitor the situation.

#### Precept\_2015/16

In January the Parish Council considered the budget, precept request and resultant impact to Council Tax payer for the 2015/16 year.

£36,600 will be needed to run village services which means an increase to Council Tax payers from £43.02 in 2014/15 to £44.36 in 2015/2016 based on a Band D property.

A government grant of £2,482 will be paid via ERYC to the Parish to help to mitigate the effects of the change in Council Tax calculations for 2015/2016. This funding will be phased out by 2017/18 therefore the Parish Council agreed to split this funding over two years to ensure the Council is in a robust position to meet future funding challenges.

## "COUNCIL CORNER"

#### December 2014:

- Following a request by the Council, East riding of Yorkshire had conducted speed surveys at 3 locations in the village during September 2014. As a result, it was found that 26.99% of daily traffic on Bridlington Road exceeded 35mph and as such now qualifies for Police speed enforcement. The results from locations at Lighthouse Road and North Marine Road were not found to qualify for intervention of speed enforcement.
- Repair work to the Carol Sandra Fishing Memorial has been commissioned and will be undertaken in the Spring of 2015.

#### January 2015:

- Following a request to ERYC the sign to the Lighthouse has been replaced.
- The precept and budget for 2015/16 was agreed.
- A new toilet cleaner and relief toilet cleaner were appointed by the Council. **February 2015:**
- The Council approved tree works to be undertaken at the Woodcock Memorial Playing Fields on South Sea Road in conjunction with Flamborough Sports Club Trust. Work will commence following a successful tree works application to ERYC.
- The Council have agreed with ERYC that the village will play host to the NHS to conduct free health checks for those aged 40-74 not currently diagnosed with any major disease on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2015.
