Local Council Elections/Community Governance Review

Following a disappointing response within the village for nominations to become a Parish Councillor, only six of the thirteen seats were filled in an uncontested election. This has left over half the seats vacant and as such the council resolved to initiate a Community Governance Review to request that Flamborough Parish Council be represented by nine councillors.

In order for the review to be taken forward by East Riding of Yorkshire Council a petition supporting the action needs to be signed by a minimum of 250 electors in the parish. Councillors will be seeking signatures for the petition and copies will also be in the Post Office and Library.

The Parish Council would like to thank the outgoing councillors for their hard work and support, not just over the last four year term but for some over many years of service. Much work goes on behind the scenes on behalf of the village and community, a recent example being the restoration to the historic pump on Crofts Hill which was freely undertaken by councillors. Maintenance of the War Memorial, Fishing Memorials and raising of flags on commemorative days are duties the council assumes to ensure that those who died are remembered in the village.

"COUNCIL CORNER"

March 2015:

- The East Riding of Yorkshire Council Street Cleansing team undertook a thorough clean of the village following concerns raised by a resident at February's parish council meeting.
- Metal detecting on Tower Fields was discussed following reports of illegal activity taking place on the site.
- East Riding of Yorkshire Council installed cycle stands at Danes Dyke and South Landing.

April 2015:

- Tree works at the Woodcock Memorial Playing Fields were undertaken on behalf of the parish council following a request from residents on South Sea Mews. These were completed at the end of April.
- The council requested a speed management assessment along Bempton Lane in response to concerns raised by a resident of the village.
- The council commissioned the repainting of the Carol Sandra Fishing Memorial plaque which was completed in April 2015.
- Goal posts were erected on the village green by Councillors Grainger and Couzens.
- The sale of part of lands comprising the village green to a property developer were agreed prior to planning permission being agreed for the old Waud Bros site.
- East Riding of Yorkshire Council were awarded the Footway Lighting Contract for 2015-2018.

May 2015:

- Councillor Crossland was elected Chairman for 2015-2016.
- Councillor Sexton was elected Vice Chairman for 2015-2016.
- Following a report from the council to ERYC regarding signage at the Lighthouse car park a review was undertaken with changes and improvements to be made.
- The council approved a planning application for the erection of a retail unit with car parking, servicing, installation of ATM, cycle parking, landscaping and associated works following demolition of redundant building at the former Waud Bros site.
