Community Governance Review/Councillor Vacancies

Following the decision to request a Community Governance Review to seek a reduction in councillor numbers from thirteen to nine, the Parish Council successfully achieved the required number of signatures to the petition required to pursue this course of action. The request has now been submitted to East Riding of Yorkshire Council for consideration. If successful, the reduction to nine councillors will take effect from the next local council elections in 2019. As such the council still has a number of vacancies for parish councillors for the 2015-2019 term.

If you have a keen interest in what happens to Flamborough and are prepared to make decisions, this could be the role for you!

To be a Parish Councillor You Must:

- *Be over 18 on the day of election and be a UK, EU or Commonwealth citizen and;*
- *Be a local government elector for the parish, or*
- *have lived within the Parish (or within 3 miles of it) for the past 12 months; or*
- *have occupied as an owner or tenant any land or premises within the Parish for the past 12 months; or*
- *have had your main place of work within the Parish for the last 12 months*

Safe and Sound Scheme

East Riding of Yorkshire Council have launched a 'Safe and Sound' grant for home owners and private tenants. The grant is to help minimise the fear of crime by providing additional home security measures to enable residents to feel safer in their home.

To qualify for assistance applicants must be:

- Aged over 60 or disabled
- In receipt of a means tested benefit
- A homeowner or private sector tenant/Housing Association tenant

Measures include:

- Additional locks for doors and windows
- Door chains
- Door viewers
- Security lights

"COUNCIL CORNER"

June 2015:

- A petition to request a Community Governance Review was approved for submission to ERYC to reduce the number of parish councillors from 13 to 9.

July 2015:

- A presentation was given by Jane Emmerson and Pay Sayers to launch a new annual fire festival to take place on New Year's Eve within the village based on the Stonehaven fireballs event.
- A 7 day speed survey was conducted on Bempton Lane in June to monitor traffic activity. The assessment results did not indicate that excessive speeding was sufficient issue on this stretch of road to warrant any Police enforcement or intervention by the ERYC Road Safety Team.
- An amended planning application pertaining to transport/delivery details was received for the former Waud Brothers site on Allison Lane. This development has been earmarked as a new site for the Co-Op supermarket. The council discussed this application at length and agreed that this would be a retrograde step from the original application proposed delivery details and resolved to inform ERYC Planning Department of the issues that were foreseen.
